21. This Act shall come into force on the first day of September, A. D. 1872. When Act to take effect.

22. Nothing in this Act shall be construed to extend to, include, or apply to births, marriages, or deaths of Chinese, or Indians. Not applicable to Chinese or Indians.

23. This Act may be cited for all purposes as "The Registration of Births, Deaths, and Marriages Act, 1872." Short Title.
