"...the city superintendent last year asked for specific report on the matter, and received from each teacher concerned his or her ideas bearing on the muchly mooted question as to their desirability of teaching Chinese along with white pupils. These reports were strikingly unanimous that in so far as the teachers and school discipline were concerned, the presence of the Chinese boys was not to the slightest degree a discordant note."

"Everyone concerned again expressed entire satisfaction with the present state of affairs. Mr. Eaton stated afterwards, with respect to the reported subversion of order in classes caused by the inability of the Chinese to understand what they are told, that there was absolutely nothing to warrant such rumors and, in fact, that they were pure fabrications."
